



Major Bradley C. Fromm

Commanding Officer, Recruiting Station Richmond

Major Fromm commissioned into the Marine Corps on 17 May 2008, after earning a Bachelor of Science degree in Systems Engineering from the University of Virginia. Upon graduating from The Basic School and the Infantry Officer Course, Major Fromm received orders to 3d Battalion, 5th Marines in September 2009. He was assigned to India Company as a Rifle Platoon Commander. While serving as the Platoon Commander for Second Platoon, he deployed in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM 10.2. Upon return to CONUS, Major Fromm took command of India Company and later served as India Company's Executive Officer for its work up and deployment on the 15th Marine Expeditionary Unit (MEU).

When he returned from the MEU, Major Fromm attended Basic Reconnaissance Course 7-13, graduating as the class Iron Man. He then reported to 1st Reconnaissance Battalion and was assigned to 1st Force Reconnaissance Company as the Operations Officer. In February 2014, he was assigned to Company C where he assumed command of 1st Platoon. He deployed with the 13th MEU as the Force Reconnaissance Detachment Platoon Commander where he conducted joint operation with Naval Special Warfare and supported the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's Operation RESTORE HOPE.

Upon return from deployment, Major Fromm executed orders, reporting to 2d Battalion, 2d Marines. On 19 December 2016, he assumed command of Company F and deployed as Crisis Response Company Commander for SPMAGTF-CR-AF 17.2/18.1. Upon relinquishing command, he checked in to Headquarters Battalion, 2d Marine Division to serve as the Division Staff Secretary. On 31 May 2019, Major Fromm assumed command of Recruiting Station Richmond.

His personal decorations include The Meritorious Service Medal, The Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal with Combat Distinguishing Device and one Gold Star, The Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, and the Combat Action Ribbon.

Major Fromm is married with two sons.
