1. Purpose. To notify all levels of Marine Corps Recruiting Command (MCRC) on the updated service agreements for Cyber (1702) Officers and action required.

2. Background. Deputy Commandant for Manpower and Reserve Affairs (M&RA) approved Cyber Officer service agreements to reflect a seventy-two (72) month Military Service Obligation (MSO) after the completion of Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) School.

3. Information. Future Cyber officers contracted will utilize the appropriate enclosure. Annex E will be utilized vice Annex B as an addendum to the DD4, Enlistment/Reenlistment Document. The service agreements are presently located on the MCRC G-3, Officer Programs command portal for use until they can be added to the Automated Commissioning Package (ACP). Reference (a) will be updated to incorporate this guidance in the next revision.

4. Qualifications. Cyber officers will meet qualifications listed in reference (a). There are no additional or unique qualifications requirements for Cyber officers.

5. Action

(a) MCRC, Officer Programs. Disseminate enclosures (1) through (6) as appropriate.

(b) Eastern/Western Recruiting Regions (ERR/WRR). Provide oversight of the Marine Corps Districts (MCDs) and ensure compliance with this FROST Call.

(c) MCDs. Ensure Officer Selection Officers (OSOs) utilize enclosures (1) and (2) for OCC and PLC, as appropriate.

(d) OSOs. Utilize these new service agreements for all PLC Cyber and OCC Cyber applicants. Applicants with existing service agreements may request component changes into Cyber Officer program, if otherwise qualified.

(e) Marine Officer Instructors (MOIs). Utilize enclosure (3) for NROTC Midshipmen and enclosure (4) for Marine Corps Enlisted Commissioning Program Cyber Marines. Applicants with existing service agreements may request component changes into Cyber Officer Program, if otherwise qualified.

(f) Military Service Academies. Utilize enclosure (5) as appropriate. Midshipmen and other service academy members requesting Cyber Officer will complete enclosure (5).

(g) Marine Corps Enlisted Commissioning Program (ECP). Marines applying for ECP Cyber Officer will utilize enclosure (6).

(h) This policy is effective the date this FROST Call is signed.
