- 1. Pursuant to reference (a), I request to delay my accession to active duty so I may complete a one-year judicial clerkship.
- 2. I certify that I meet the eligibility requirements for a delay of accession to active duty in order to complete a one-year judicial clerkship. Enclosure (1) verifies that I have completed the requirements for my law degree. Enclosure (2) verifies that I have been offered a one-year judicial clerkship.
- 3. I certify that I will take the first scheduled bar examination in a state of my choosing and send to MCRC proof of bar examination passage upon receipt. I also certify that I will submit to MCRC documentation from my state bar confirming their receipt of my complete application for a license to practice law.
- 4. I have provided a current physical fitness test score in enclosure (3).
- 5. Enclosure (4) contains my personal statement explaining why I am requesting a delay of accession to active duty in order to complete a oneyear judicial clerkship.
- 6. I understand that this is only a request and that a delay of accession to active duty is not guaranteed. All such decisions will be based upon the needs of the Marine Corps.
- 7. I understand that I must apply to my state bar for a license to practice law immediately upon notification of bar examination passage in order to continue my delay of accession to active duty.

If I have not received a license to practice law by that date, I understand that I will be transferred to the PLC-Ground Program and assigned to The Basic School as an unrestricted ground officer.
